

The Trilogy Foundation Emergency Food Assistance Policy

Information

1. Public and private schools across the nation from pre-school through the university level are evaluating whether schools should implement a temporary closure to prevent the spread of Coronavirus amongst vulnerable populations.
2. Some schools have already implemented temporary closures, and we expect more to follow suit.
3. Some Campus employees throughout Trilogy may face unexpected financial hardships due to the impact of these school closures in the form of unexpected costs such as childcare and meals that are covered during school hours. To assist with financial hardships, Trilogy is prepared to offer meal assistance for *children* who are unable to attend school and receive free/discounted meals by providing the following:
 - a. One package of food is to subsidize breakfast and lunch for two children.
 - b. One package of food is to subsidize for the five-day school week.

Packages

1. Two packages will be offered thereby allowing employees to pick what is best suited for their children's preferences. Items cannot be substituted/interchanged during this time.
2. One package is to subsidize meals for every 2 children an employee has that is out of school due to Coronavirus closures. Employees are eligible to receive packages as stated:
 - a. 1-2 Children: 1 Package
 - b. 3-4 Children: 2 Packages
 - c. 5-6 Children: 3 Packages
 - d. 7-8 Children: 4 Packages
 - e. 9-10 Children: 5 Packages
3. Two package options have been outlined with non-perishable food items based on availability. If an item on a list becomes unavailable, it will be substituted for a similar item. Package options are as follows:
 - a. Option 1: Cereal, oatmeal, fruit cups, peanut butter, jelly, applesauce, granola bars, pasta noodles, marinara sauce, and canned tuna.
 - b. Option 2: Cereal, oatmeal, orange fruit cups, peanut butter, jelly, applesauce, packaged cookies, crackers, soup
4. Packages to be ordered and sent to employees address through the Walmart delivery service.

Eligibility:

1. Must be a full or part time employee of Trilogy Health Services, Paragon Rehabilitation, or PCA Pharmacy.
2. Children must be 17 years old or younger and a financial dependent of the employee.

3. Children must be enrolled at a school that has closed as a result of Coronavirus (COVID-19). Employees with children who are still in school with no closures are not eligible for food packages at this time.
4. Families that are currently participating in a free and discounted meal program.
