



FAQ: TNA to CNA Bridge Program

- **Who is eligible for this program?**

As of February 8th, this rollout program is only available to RCAs in the state of Indiana. However, we are working with other states to get this program approved.

- **What do I do after completing the TNA to CNA Course?**

Upon completion of the bridge program, an employee must apply for the state exam through Ivy Tech Community College. More information on how to apply for this exam is to come.

- **What is my login information for Cinematic?**

For those of you who did not take the 8-hour Waiver course on the Cinematic platform, you also will soon receive an email notifying you that you have been enrolled in the CNA Bridge Training Program. When you click on the link in the email, you will be prompted to create your account. Your Username will be your email address, and you will create your own Password. Fill in the remaining requested information, and you can begin the program.

- **How long is the TNA to CNA Bridge Program?**

The TNA to CNA Education is only 24 hours. The typical in-person CNA class is 75 hours.
